DASH DISASSEMBLY


Fig.A 1. Use a panel removal tool to remove the side panels on the right and left sides of the centre console (Fig. A). 2. Remove the six (6) Torx screws from behind the side panels. (Fig. B, a,b,c) _____ 3. Remove the middle part of the centre console and disconnect all connections (Fig. C). Fig.B



4. Open both cup holders. Remove the two (2) Torx screws (now exposed following centre console removal) and remove the cup holders (Fig. D).

5. Press the two (2) plastic clips located under the OEM radio (Fig. E) and remove the OEM radio.







KIT ASSEMBLY

6. Mount the left and right brackets to the aftermarket head unit (Fig. F).

Note: the position of the copper-coloured can be adjusted for a perfect fit (Fig. G).

NOTES

7. Push the fascia panel into the dashboard, and push the stereo cage into the fascia panel (Fig. H).

8. Make all wiring connections to the aftermarket head unit and push it into the stereo cage until it clips into place. Surround with the trim panel.

9. Install all other components in the reverse order of disassembly to complete the installation (Fig. I).
